Extension of validity of Accreditation period from 5 years to 7 years in respect of high performing institutions - Amendment to notification dated 16th January 2017

In continuation of the Notification No.: 1/2017 dated 16th January 2017, the Executive Committee (EC) in its 76th meeting held on 17th March 2017 made further clarification with respect to highest grade to have been obtained in nine-point scale in vogue during the period 16th March 2002 to 31st March 2007.

The '**A**' Grade and above (i.e., institutional score 85 – 100) in the nine-point scale applicable between 16th March 2002 to 31st March 2007, will be considered as obtaining highest grade for qualifying for extension of validity period for accreditation by NAAC from five years to seven years, subject to the condition that the institution satisfies the other conditions specified in the notification referred above.
