



A Brief Report on 3rd 2-Day Workshop on Revised NAAC Framework

Commissionerate of Collegiate Education, Govt. of Telangana has proposed for organizing 3 Workshops of 2 Day each on NAAC Revised Frame work on during Nov and Dec 2018 and consulted NAAC Bangalore for financial assistance. NAAC Bangalore has approved the proposal and also nominated NAAC officials to be the keynote speakers. The workshops are proposed to be organized on 29-30 Nov, 13-14 Dec and 17-18 Dec 2018.

The 3rd workshop was organized on 17th & 18th December 2018. 23 Colleges were identified and 3 from each college including Principal and IQAC Coordinator are nominated to attend the workshop. All the colleges which are due for fresh accreditation have taken part in the workshop. Most of the participants have experienced the NAAC process in their old station and recently moved to their current station. The workshops are organized at Dr.BR Ambedkar Open University, Jubilee Hills, Hyderabad.

The workshop was opened with Special Invitee and Keynote Speaker Dr.Vinita Sahu's session at 10.45 AM on 17th Dec 2018. It was a two and half hour long session where the speaker made the participants understand the QNM, QLM, Data Validation and SSS processes clearly. She has explained the process with examples and there was a good interaction through-out the session.

Dr.Smitha Asthana, Smt.R.Komala and Smt.Nagalakshmi are the resource persons for the 4 technical sessions on Preparation of SSR in the revised frame work, Submission of documents-data validation, Student Satisfaction Survey and Peer Team visit. The resource persons being the IQAC Coordinators of the colleges which were recently accredited with A+ grade have shared their experiences for achieving better grade.

The participants were asked to prepare an action plan and submit. They have presented their plan of action and appreciated the Commissionerate for organizing the workshop which is the need of the hour.
