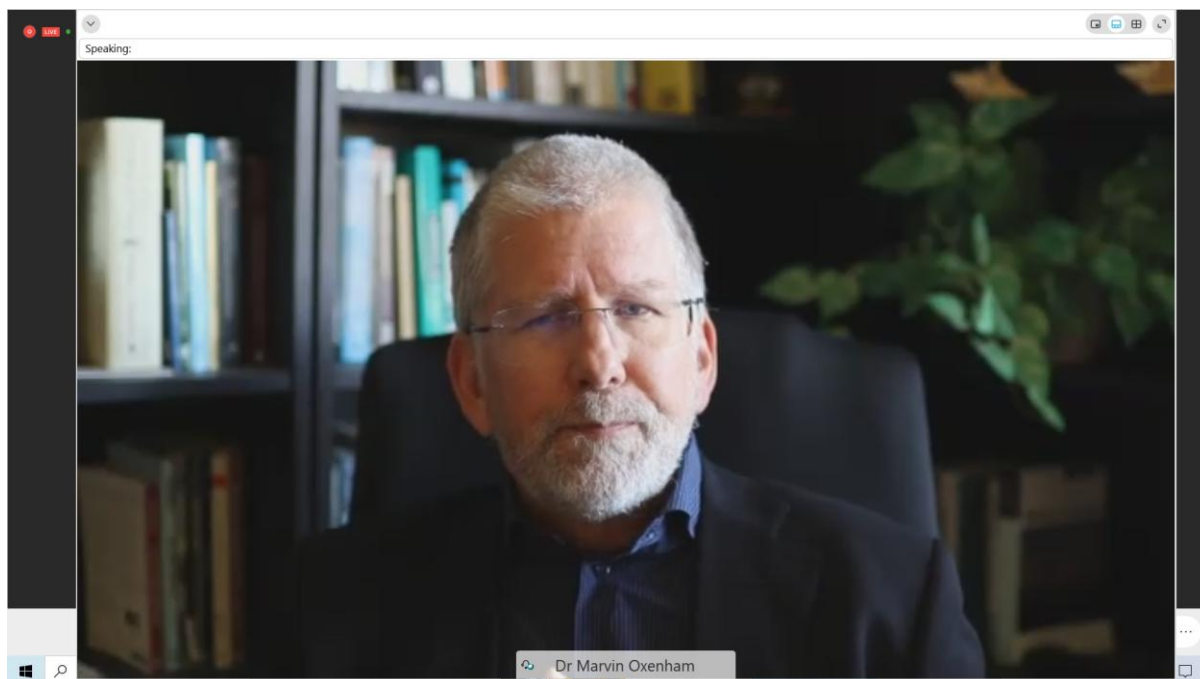


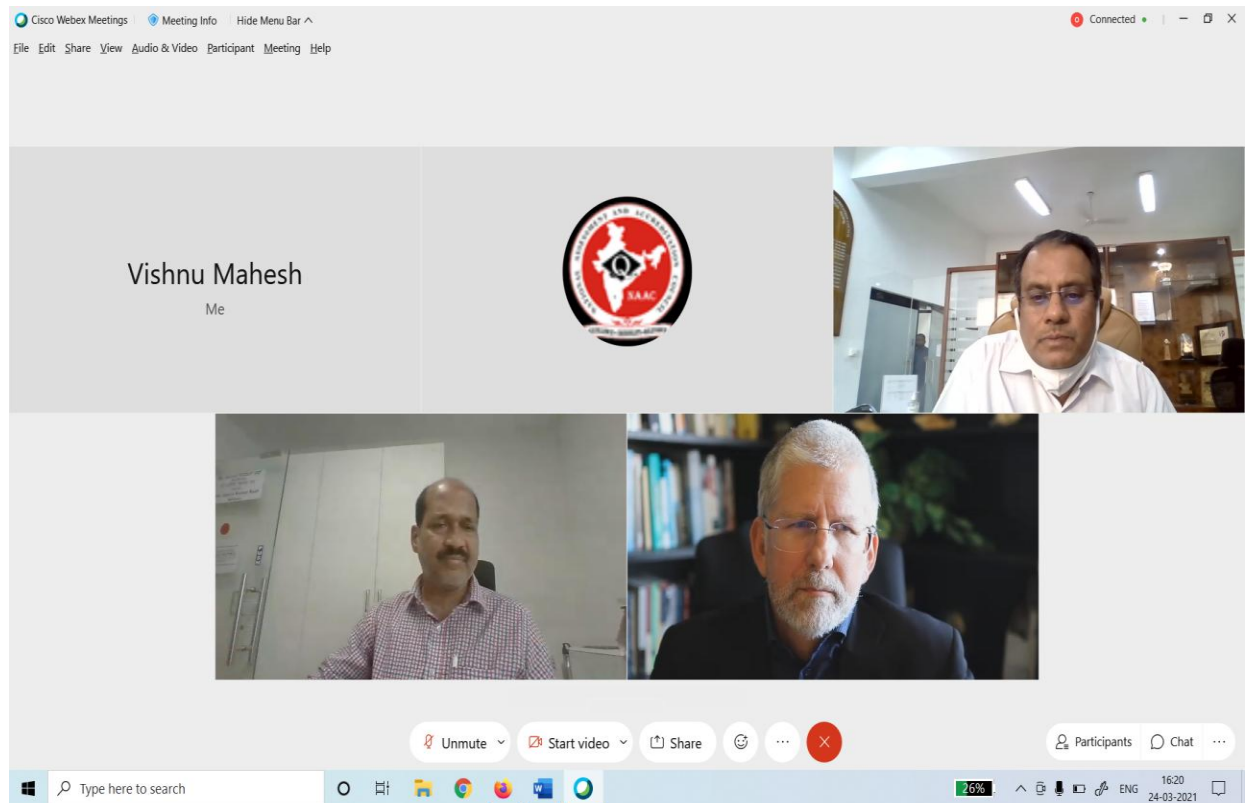
BRIEF REPORT ON

International Webinar in International Webinar Series on “QUALITY ASSURANCE AND CHARACTER EDUCATION HIGHER EDUCATION”

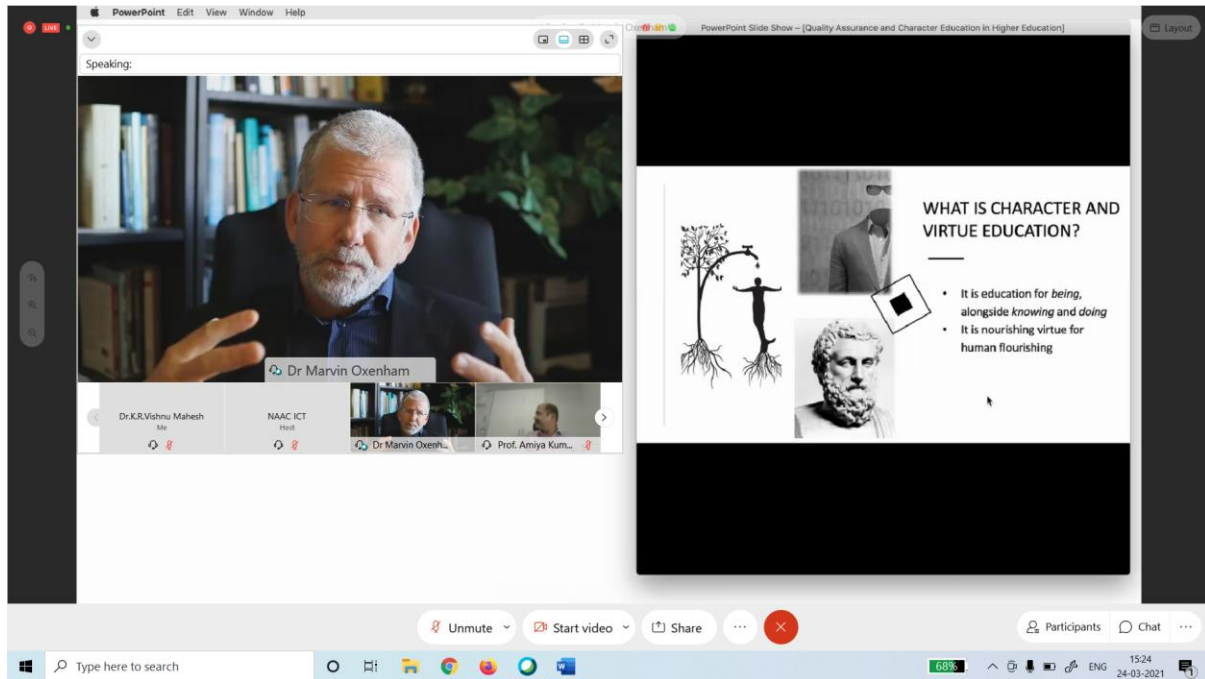
