About the University:

Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University Hyderabad was established on 2nd October, 1972. The State Government of combined state of Andhra Pradesh through A.P. Govt. Act No.30 of 2008 has separated the erstwhile JNTU into four different Universities viz., JNT University Anantapur, JNT University Kakinada, JNT University Hyderabad and JNA&FA University Hyderabad.

JNT University Anantapur started functioning from the campus of one of its constituent colleges at Ananthapuramu, since August 2008. As a budding University it is committed to develop and nurture a Technical Education System in the four districts of Rayalaseema viz., Ananthapuramu, Chittoor, YSR Kadapa, Kurnool districts and SPSR Nellore district which would produce skilled man power of high quality comparable to the best in the world and in adequate numbers to meet the complex technological needs of the economy.

This University has four constituent units, viz.

1. JNTUA College of Engineering (Autonomous), Ananthapuramu, established in the year 1946 at Guindy campus, Chennai and subsequently shifted to Anantapur in the year 1948.
2. JNTUA College of Engineering (Autonomous), Pulivendula, established in the year 2006.
3. JNTUA Oil Technological & Pharmaceutical Research Institute, Ananthapuramu, established in the year 1949.
4. JNTUA College of Engineering, Kalikiri, established in the year 2013.

In addition to the above, University has 167 affiliated colleges which include 102 Engineering colleges, 36 Pharmacy colleges, 29 Standalone PG colleges. Department of MBA is present in the University Campus.

Amongst them, 18 institutions have been granted autonomous status, 43 institutions have been recognized under 2(f) & 12(B) status of the UGC, 19 institutions are accredited by NAAC and various programs offered by 17 institutions are accredited by NBA.

Webinar Objectives:

As many of the institutions under this University are to be accredited for NAAC, it is felt that a webinar is to be organised to appraise the institutions and faculty members about the recent developments in the NAAC assessment and accreditation process.

Programme:

The inspirational inaugural address by the JNTUA Vice-Chancellor, Prof. S. Srinivas Kumar set the right tone for the webinar.
