



# Report on *Two days NAAC Workshop*

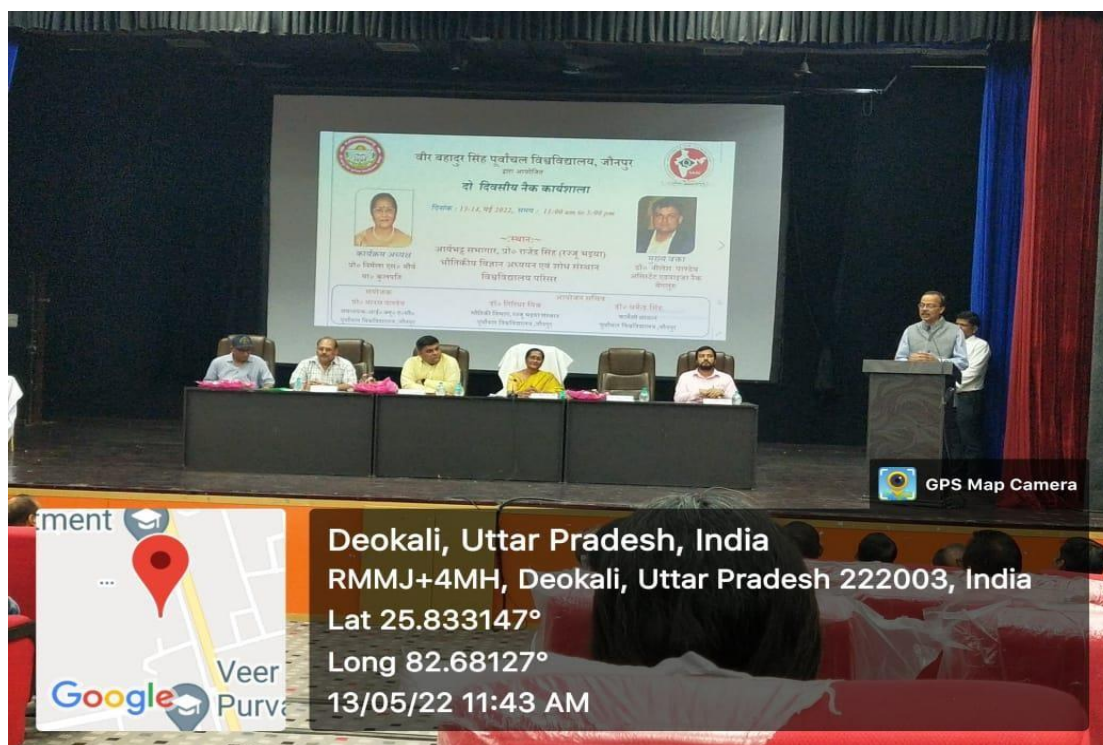

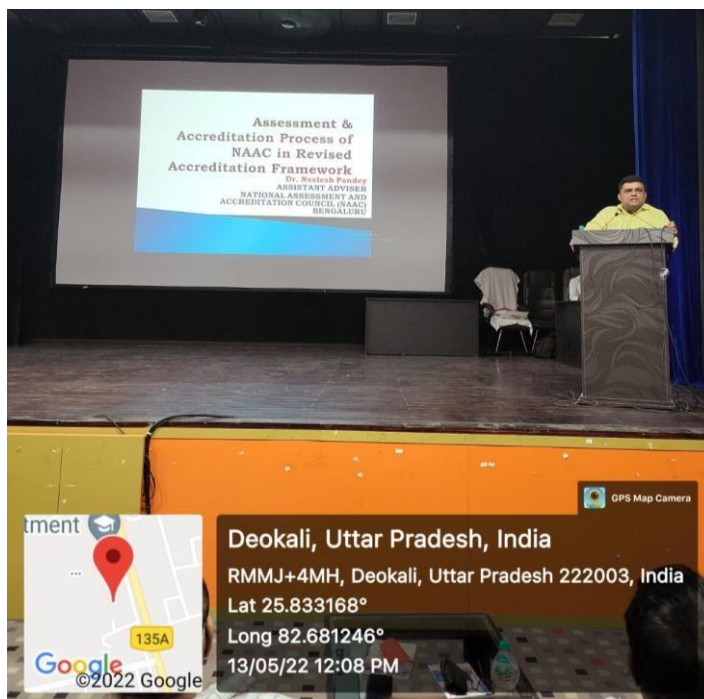
In order to acquaint the faculties and staff of Veer Bahadur Singh Purvanchal University and its affiliated colleges about the new procedures, importance and benefits of acquiring NAAC accreditation, a two days workshop was organised by VBS Purvanchal University, Jaunpur in the Aryabhata Auditorium of Prof. Rajendra Singh (Rajju Bhaiya) Institute of Physical Sciences for Study and Research. The inauguration ceremony had on dais- Prof. Nirmala S. Mourya- Honourable Vice Chancellor of VBS Purvanchal University, Dr. Neelesh Pandey- Assistant Advisor NAAC, Bengaluru, Prof. Manas Pandey- Coordinator, IQAC, VBSPU and Convener of the workshop, Shri Sanjay Kumar Rai-Finance Officer, Shri. V.N. Singh-Controller of Examination, Dr. Giridhar Mishra and Dr. Dharmendra Singh-Organising Secretaries of the NAAC Workshop. The workshop was formally inaugurated with the traditional ceremony of lighting up of lamps and Goddess Saraswati Vandana performed by students of VBSPU.



Welcome speech was given by Prof. Manas Pandey- Coordinator IQAC. Prof. Pandey welcomed the guests and thanked them for giving time and gracing the occasion despite of their busy schedule. Prof. Pandey highlighted the objective of conducting the workshop and gave the program details. He also elaborated the importance of accreditation by NAAC and said that accreditation has large number of benefits including fundings from government and also it is beneficial as NEP, 2020 has been implemented in VBSPU and its affiliated colleges in full-fledged manner.

Prof. Nirmala S. Mourya, Honourable Vice Chancellor of VBS Purvanchal University in her presidential address focused on Importance of Accreditation in Educational Institutions. She stressed the importance of getting NAAC accreditation by 2022 as per the Quality mandate of UGC.

In the first session, Principal Speaker of the two days workshop, Dr. Neelesh Pandey Assistant Advisor of NAAC, Bangalore guided the participants as the resource person on various NAAC parameters to grade universities and degree colleges. He said that NAAC is instituted to promote institutions to help and achieve quality assurance and face the challenge and also NAAC framework for assessment and accreditation is unique to any other country and the assessment is based on Global Good Practices and Norms.



He explained minute details of the Assessment & Accreditation process beginning with the eligibility criteria to online submission of 'Institutional Information for Quality Assessment (IIQA)'. He said that some points must be kept in mind while preparing for NAAC accreditation such as importance of strict adherence to timeline, frequent visit of NAAC website, dashboard, Standard Operating Procedure, need to give importance in preparing SSR, once it is submitted it cannot be edited, Timeline for DVV queries and as the Students Satisfaction Survey has been introduced in the revised framework, details and awareness of the students should also be addressed. He further stated that tutorials and helpdesk are available for the purpose.

In the second session, Dr. Pandey deliberated upon "Peer Team Visit" and informed that the responses to Qualitative Metrics will be reviewed by the Peer Team on site only after the institution clears the Pre-qualifier stage. After the talk of Dr. Pandey, the workshop was open to address the queries and questions of the participants. Dr. Pandey and Coordinator of IQAC, VBSPU jointly answered to the questions. The queries were related to various criteria of NAAC, online submission of data, Student Satisfaction Survey, data on student progression, placement etc. First day of the workshop was ended by vote of thanks given by Dr. Pradeep Kumar, Department of Biotechnology, VBSPU.

On second day, first session was composed of presentations which were made by all the departments of VBSPU regarding their preparedness for applying for accreditation. During the presentations, our Honourable Vice Chancellor and Dr. Neelesh Pandey jointly advised for removal of various shortcomings and encouraged the departments to come forward actively for accreditation.
