Report of One Day National Webinar on Revised Accreditation Framework of NAAC

India has one of the largest and diverse education systems in the world. The education system right from its inception has gone through several changes to cope up with the time. As per the demand of time and people, few things have been introduced into the system like privatization, increased autonomy and introduction of Programmes in new and emerging areas. But along with such things, there comes the concerns like maintaining the quality in education system and many more. To address these concerns, the National Policy on Education (NPE, 1986) and the Programme of Action (PoA, 1992) spelt out strategic plans for the policies, advocated the establishment of an independent National accreditation agency. Consequently, the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) was established in 1994 as an autonomous institution of the University Grants Commission (UGC) with its Head Quarter in Bengaluru. NAAC has changed its accreditation framework, wherever and whenever it becomes necessary. The faculty of Universities/ Institutes, educationalists and all the stakeholders should always be updated about this accreditation framework of NAAC. Recently NAAC has revised its accreditation framework for institutes and universities. Therefore, in order to make all the stakeholders aware about the revised accreditation framework of NAAC, the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of Punyashlok Ahilyadevi Holkar Solapur University, Solapur (M.S.) planned a National webinar in collaboration with National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC), Bengaluru.

The said One Day National Webinar on Revised Accreditation Framework of NAAC was scheduled on July 27th, 2020 at 11 pm. A registration form was prepared using Google form and the link of this registration form was given wide publicity. The organizing committee got overwhelming response from different corners of the country. Total of 958 registrations were received for the webinar. Webinar was conducted through google meet, and live streaming of the google meet was done on University IQAC channel. The organisers were fortunate to have eminent experts from NAAC, Bengaluru as resource persons for the webinar. These were: Dr. Ganesh Hegade (Adviser, NAAC), Dr. Leena Gahane (Deputy Adviser, NAAC), Dr. N.R. Mohan (Asst. Adviser, NAAC) and Dr. A.V. Prasad (Asst. Adviser, NAAC).

The webinar started with welcome speech by Prof. V. B. Patil, Convener of webinar and Director, IQAC of the University. He greeted all the participants and resource persons and narrated the outline of webinar. This welcome speech was followed by introductory address by Dr. Mrunalini Fadnavis, Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, Punyashlok Ahilyadevi Holkar Solapur University, Solapur. In her introductory speech, she stressed on need of such webinars and also explained about recent developments of Punyashlok Ahilyadevi Holkar Solapur University, Solapur. There were total four technical sessions. The first session was delivered by Dr. Ganesh Hegade (Adviser, NAAC), who took an Overview of NAAC Assessment and Accreditation, Registration and Submission of IIQA. Dr. A.V. Prasad (Asst. Adviser, NAAC), alongwith Dr. Ganesh Hegade guided about preparation and submission of Self Study Report. In the third session, Dr. N.R. Mohan (Asst. Adviser, NAAC) narrated about Data Validation and Verification Process. Dr. Leena Gahane (Deputy Adviser, NAAC) in the last technical session explained about Student Satisfaction Survey, Onsite visit

and Accreditation Outcome. All the sessions were fruitful for the participants, as can be seen from comments in live session. Participants found all the sessions to be informative as well as innovative. Apart from NAAC documentation, DVV and PTV, the sessions touched various other topics such as Bloom's taxonomy, education during Covid-19 pandemic etc. The queries about revised accreditation framework of NAAC were invited from participants in the registration form. More than 100 queries were received and nearly all these queries were answered by resource persons in Question-answer session. The webinar concluded with Vote of thanks by Mr. C. G. Gardi, member of IQAC, Punyashlok Ahilyadevi Holkar Solapur University, Solapur. The technical part of this online webinar was taken care by Dr. S. D. Raut and Mr. C. G. Gardi, IQAC members.
