Accreditation – Transition Autonomous Colleges

The NAAC has thoroughly analysed the results of institutions which are in the transition phase of autonomy and the following has been resolved:

1. The NAAC may extend the Accreditation Status of Autonomous Colleges till they become eligible for applying as an Autonomous Institution, i.e., 5 years or 2 batches of students graduated under Autonomy, **whichever is earlier**.
2. For all transition Autonomous Colleges, whose results have been declared under the Revised Accreditation Framework (RAF), an option is provided to extend validity period of their previous accreditation status (till they fulfill the eligibility requirement) or avail of the new Grade.
