A One Day Workshop on “Quality Assessment and Accreditation under Revised Accreditation Framework (RAF) of NAAC (NAP)” was organized on 19th July, 2019 by Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC), Kakatiya University, Warangal in collaboration with National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC), Bangalore for the affiliated colleges of Kakatiya University. The workshop was formally inaugurated by Hon’ble Vice-Chancellor of the University, Prof. R. Sayanna. Dr. Sujata P. Shanbhagh, Deputy Advisor, NAAC, Bangalore and Prof. A. Ravinder Nath, Dean, Faculty of Technology, Osmania University, Hyderabad were Principal Resource persons. Prof. K. Purushotham, Registrar, Kakatiya University, Prof. S. Mahender Reddy, Controller of Examinations, Prof. Ch. Rajesham, Dean, College Development Council and Prof. T. Ramesh, Dean, Academic Audit Cell of the University were other invited dignitaries graced the programme. Prof. Garlapati Achaiah, Coordinator, IQAC-KU in his welcome address highlighted the objective of conducting the workshop and gave the program details. Around 300 delegates participated from about 200 colleges. These include Principals, management members

(Secretary/correspondent) and their representatives from affiliated colleges who are engaged with NAAC accreditation.



Prof. R Sayanna, Vice-chancellor has stressed the importance of getting NAAC accreditation by 2022 as per the Quality mandate of UGC. He appealed to all non-accredited affiliated colleges of the university to start preparations for applying for NAAC accreditation.

The workshop comprised of two technical sessions followed by hands on training on online registration and submission of SSR (Self Study Report). In the first session, Prof. A. Ravinder Nath, Dean, Faculty of Technology, Osmania University, Hyderabad delivered a talk on ‘Accreditation as a Measure of Institutional Quality’. He said that the quality assurance ensures the Accreditation mechanism, Assessment method and Ranking process. Dr Sujata Shanbagh of NAAC Bangalore spoke the

online process of Assessment and Accreditation by NAAC and highlighted the **Revised** Accreditation Framework and explained the following aspects of RAF:

- Data Driven A & A framework
- Validation of data by external agency
- Online Student Satisfaction survey
- System selection of peer team members
- A & A process complete automation
- Online submission of application



In the post lunch hands on training session, Dr. Sujata demonstrated the online process of registration and filing of SSR (Self Study Report) etc. She clarified the doubts raised by the delegates at the end of the session. The programme concluded with the vote of thanks by Prof. G. Achaiah, Director, IQAC, KU, Warangal.
