<p>Highlights of the programme :</p> <p>1) Dr.B.S.Madhukar, Bengaluru: He gave an overall view of NAAC assessment and what is the role of higher education institutes towards quality sustenance and enhancement. He briefed about the NAAC new guidelines and expectations from the higher education institutes towards getting accreditation to achieve good grades.</p> <p>2) Dr.Nandkumar Samant, Principal, SP Chowgule College, Madgaon, Goa: Gave information on 1st Criteria and 4th Criteria in detail, explaining the key aspects under these criteria. He elaborated all the key aspects and the requirement of NAAC giving his own institution examples.</p> <p>3) Dr.S.S.Gawati, Principal, Hukkeri: He gave elaborated talk on criteria 3 - Research, Innovation and Extension in detail with key aspects. He also briefed about E-resources.</p> <p>4) Dr. M. B. Kothale, Principal, GIB Nippani: Briefed about the NAAC and gave the overview of the NAAC accreditation process highlighting the major key aspects from all the 7 criteria major changes in the new guidelines, student satisfaction survey, best practices, calculation of CGPA etc. He elaborated the Criteria 2: Teaching Learning and Evaluation in detail. He also highlighted important activities of his institution and how to prepare the SSR and AQAR. He also highlighted the role of IQAC and management for sustenance of quality in the institution.</p> <p>In the Best Practices poster presentation session, Mr.Suraj S Mense of Geology Dept., GSS College, presented the poster on "Welcome to Freshers by Seniors and Farewell to Seniors by Juniors", a best practice of Geology Department; Mr.Yoesh M Kutre of Geology Dept., GSS College, Belgaum, presented the poster on "Geo-Tectonics - an event Learn with Fun" with details such as aims and objectives, methods and outcome of the activity; and Shri.R.T.Katamble of Chemistry Dept., GSS College, Belgaum presented the poster on Best practice of the Campus Clean Drive work by all the staff and students who undertake on every last Saturday of the month.
