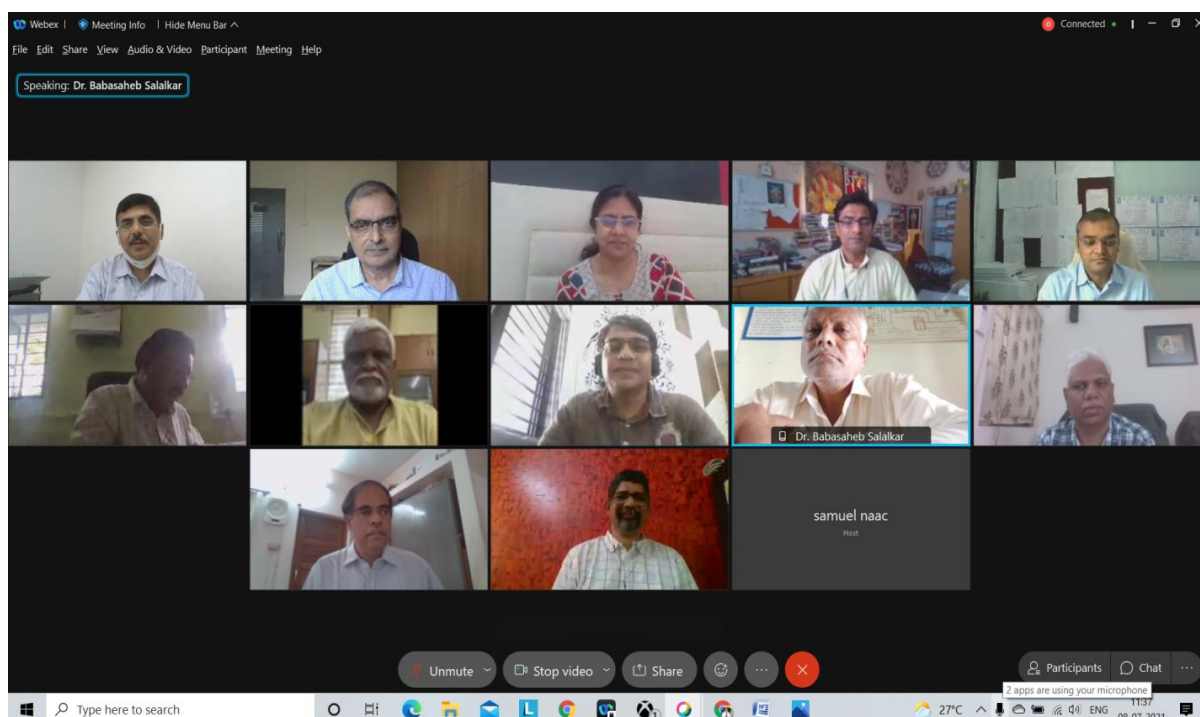


Report on Virtual – Assessors Orientation Programme (V-AOP) from Western Region hosted by NAAC through Cisco Webex platform on 7th – 8th July 2021.

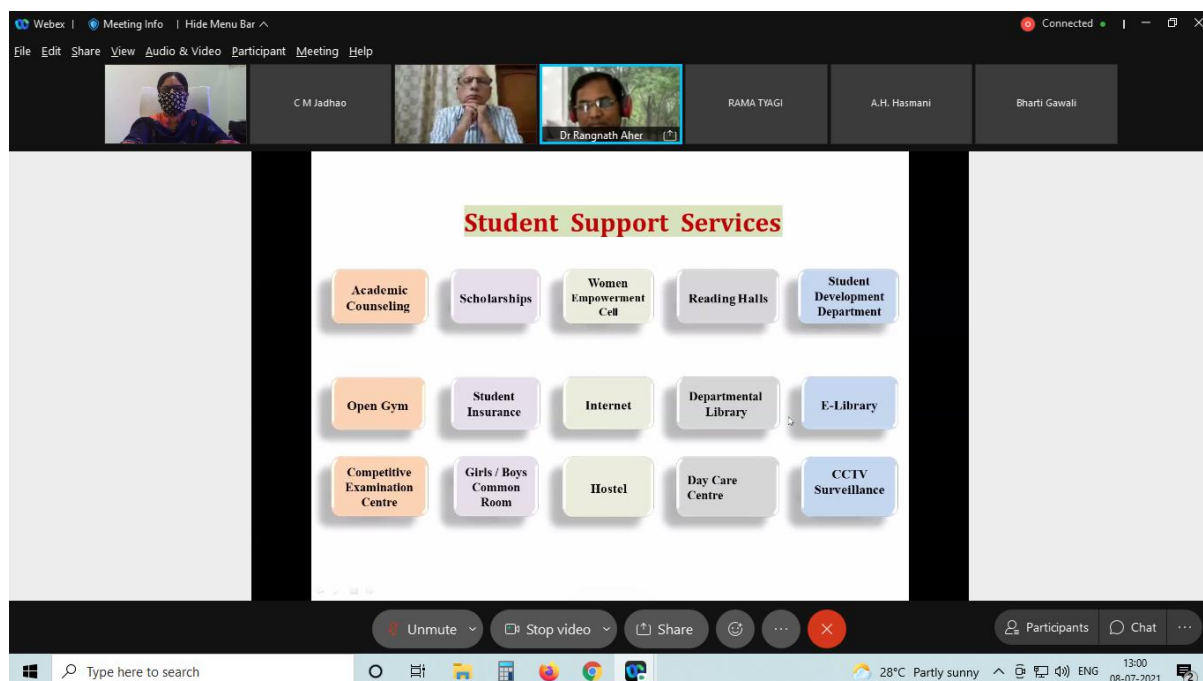
The Virtual Assessors Orientation Programme (V-AOP) was organized for 2 days during 7th - 8th July 2021, Twenty one distinguished Academicians from western region of different states have attended the programme. The participants included Vice-Chancellors, Directors, Professors and Principals from premier Institutions belonging to different disciplines or specialties. The purpose of the V-AOP is to equip and update the prospective Assessors regarding the Assessment and Accreditation process in the Revised Accreditation Framework.



Dr. Devender Kawday, Deputy Adviser, NAAC welcomed the distinguished guests and the esteemed participants to the Virtual - Assessors' Orientation Programme (V-AOP). In his welcome address, emphasized the importance of Assessors in the process and touched upon effects of Revised Accreditation Framework (RAF).

In Session–I: Dr. Devender Kawday, Deputy Adviser spoke, on Overview of Assessment and Accreditation Process and introduction to V-AOP.

In Session–II: Dr. L. Manujantha Rao, Deputy Adviser spoke on the process of Data Validation and Verification (DVV) and Accreditation Outcome.



In Session–III: Prof. Amiya Kumar Rath, Adviser spoke on ICT perspective in Assessment and Accreditation process of NAAC and different modules of NAAC with online demonstration.

In Session–IV: Dr. A.V. Prasad, Assistant Adviser, spoke on modalities of peer team visits and procedure to be adopted for peer team visit Logistics.

In Session–V: Dr. Leena Gahane, Deputy Adviser, spoke on how to prepare Peer Team report and Peer Review Score sheet during peer team visit.

In Session–VI: Dr. Devender Kawday, Deputy Adviser, spoke on the Modalities for preparing and submitting the Peer Team Report and Score sheet in the NAAC Assessor portal. The participants were divided into two groups.

The group – II was co-ordinated by Dr. Leena Gahane, Deputy Adviser and Dr. A.V. Prasad, Assistant Adviser.

The respective group co-ordinators have explained the purpose of group activity and the tasks which are involved in each group, each group was asked to prepare

a complete peer team report and score sheet based on the sample self – study report (SSR) (case study) which is sent to all the participants. In each group one participant is made as Chairman and member co-ordinator. The group have discussed each metric based on the sample SSR, the participants have given their opinion individually with in the group, collectively prepared the peer team report. This exercise was done from 2.00 pm to 5.00pm on day one and 10.00am to 1.00pm on day two. The respective co-ordinators have monitored the group activity with proper assistance.

In Session – VIII:

Presentation of the Report by each Group – 30 minutes. (Chairman’s and Rapporteur’s presentation) with proper justification for each metric from 2.00pm to 3.00pm.
